Please note that all Fees for monuments should be paid **by cheque**, made payable to the “**PCC of Cowfold**”, not to our Parish Priests. (*Part of these fees is sent to the Diocese to make up clerical stipends, etc.; the rest remains with the PCC as a necessary part of church income*).

Please note that whereas these fees will be payable to the PCC of Cowfold, a separate charge will be made by the stonemason for the cost of a headstone, and the carved inscription thereon. For a memorial tablet, the PCC can make the arrangements on your behalf with a local firm, based in Horsham, but if you wish to make your own arrangements, the tablet will be supplied by the PCC.

Further Notes:

¹ The original inscription on such monuments must be approved by the Incumbent, (acting on behalf of, and in accordance with, the regulations made by the Chancellor of the Diocese of Chichester.) For more information, including permitted materials for a headstone, please contact Fr. Keith.

² The tablets can only be obtained through St. Peter's Churchwardens to ensure uniformity in the size and design of tablets in our Garden of Remembrance, making the whole area look more beautiful. The inscription can only record the following details:

FULL NAME, DATE OF BIRTH, DATE OF BURIAL/DEATH.
