All the fees should be paid to 'PCC of Cowfold' by cheque, or bank transfer to account number 00282330, sort code 30-94-41. A part of the statutory fees is sent to the Diocese to contribute to clerical stipends etc.

Please note that when a headstone is required, a separate charge will be made by the stonemason for the cost of that headstone, and the carved inscription thereon. If a memorial tablet is required, the PCC can make the necessary arrangements on your behalf with a local firm based in Horsham, but you can of course make your own arrangements, if you prefer. In either event, the tablet itself must be obtained through the PCC (see note 2, below)

Notes:

¹ The original inscription on such monuments must be approved by the Incumbent, (acting on behalf of, and in accordance with, the regulations made by the Chancellor of the Diocese of Chichester.) For more information, including permitted materials for a headstone, please contact Rev'd Sue.

² The tablets can only be obtained through St. Peter's Churchwardens to ensure uniformity in the size and design of tablets in our Garden of Remembrance, making the whole area look more beautiful. The inscription can only record the following details:

FULL NAME, DATE OF BIRTH, DATE OF DEATH.
